66.6% of respondents indicated "supporting the PWOW mission" and "professional development opportunities" as reasons they joined PWOW.

How does your PWOw membership meet your professional expectations?-

"Very much what I want. There are services provided by the members that I would not have ever known about had I not met them at PWOw. It is a great way to meet professional women to share ideas and learn about services I could employ for my own business. The social aspect is wonderful, too."

"It is an excellent opportunity for more in-depth networking than other organizations I am involved with. I also appreciate that the programs provide valuable information to me as a woman in business. I would like to see more women at the meetings to enhance the networking value, however."

"I've enjoyed many of the women I have met through PWOW, but I have gained no business from belonging to the group."

"I have built long standing and meaningful relationships with PWOW. Additionally these relationships have enabled me to make business connections that have led to programs that benefit the community."

"The opportunity to network with other women in various businesses and organizations. Also, the chance to give back to the community."

"Partially. Meeting only once per month inhibits being able to get to know one another better. I would prefer twice per month..."

44.4% of the members surveyed attended After Hours Networking Events within the last year.

85.1% of members surveyed indicated they are "very satisfied" or "somewhat satisfied" with their PWOW membership.

80% of members surveyed indicated the benefits they receive through PWOw membership appropriately relate to the annual membership cost.

92.5% of respondents have recommended PWOw membership to another professional woman in Williamson County. But only 62.9% are likely to recommend PWOw membership to another professional woman in Williamson County in the future.

What role should PWOw play to better meet your professional needs?

"Mainly for finding out what businesses there are out there that I might use or refer others to. It is helpful to actually know the person who has the business before choosing to use one. It is also helpful to me if someone meets me and chooses to
